#### Girls Uniform

- Royal blue cardigan/jumper (with school badge)
- Blue/white summer dress.
- **Black shoes to be worn from this year**
- P.E. Kit: White t-shirt (with school badge) with royal blue shorts/games skirt and black pumps
- Plain blue , white or plain grey socks or tights
- **Small** royal blue or white hair accessories only

#### Boys Uniform

- Pale blue polo shirt with school badge
- Royal blue jumper with school badge
- Grey trousers (short or long - according to preference)
