Dear Parents and Carers,

We have started two health initiatives in school this week; GULP (Give Up Loving Pop), this initiative is aimed at reducing the amount of sugar children consume daily. The KS2 children were involved in an interactive assembly educating them about how many spoons of sugar are in certain drinks. The children have brought home a red postcard asking them to pledge their support of this campaign by giving up sugary drinks for 21 days starting 8th May. Parents can help children sign up on line – all information is on the red postcard. Additional GULP postcards are available at the school Office.

The second initiative is the Daily Mile. Children are taken out onto the playground or field to walk or run for ten minutes every day! They are encouraged to count their laps covered and challenge themselves to beat the previous day's lap count every day!
