

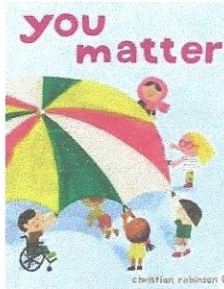

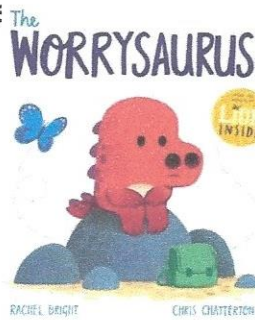
# Book Time

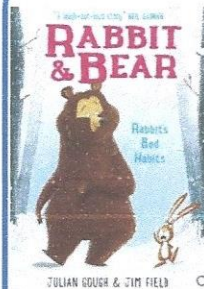


## Infants get to know your authors:

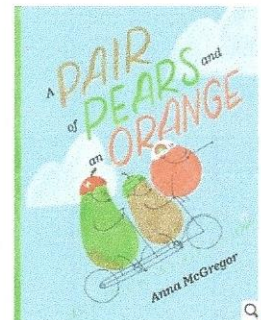

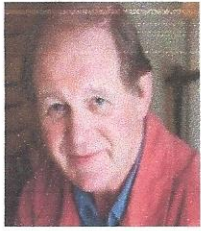

An adorable story about making new friends and finding creative solutions to playground problems.

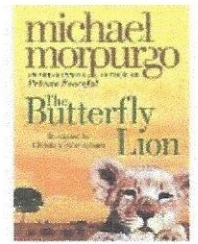






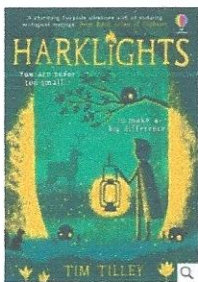
## Juniors get to know your authors:

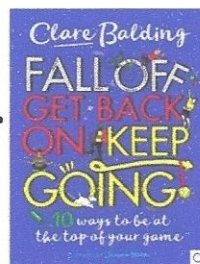
