- Grey, royal blue or white socks

- No jewellery except small stud earrings and a wrist watch.

Summer Uniforms

- Grey Skirt, pinafores or short trousers
- Pale Blue School polo with badge

Children are **not allowed** to bring in any bags, pencil cases or any of their own pencils/pens etc
