## The Feast day of Saints Peter and Paul - 29<sup>th</sup> June

*Peter and Paul are two very important characters from the Early Church.*

*Peter was the most frequently mentioned member of the original 12 Apostles, who travelled with Jesus throughout His Public Ministry and could testify to the Resurrection. Jesus foretold that this apostle would be the rock upon which the Church would be built. Despite Peter's betrayal of Jesus after His Arrest, St Peter led the Apostles, became the first pope and was martyred for his faith.*

*Paul was converted from a strict Jew who persecuted Christians to the greatest missionary of Christianity: the Apostle of the Gentiles. He is the author of most of the Letters of the New Testament.*
