Open days

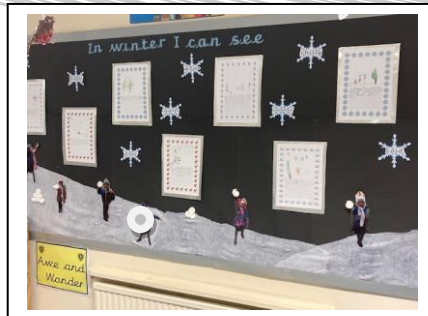
Unfortunately, again this year, we are unable to accommodate a parents' open day in school.


