During September our whole school attendance has not been very good! In the last 5 weeks the totals have been: 91%, 94.4%, 94.4%, 93% and 93%. These totals are very low for our school.

For example - in Ks1 a day consists of Phonics, Reading, English, Handwriting, Maths plus two other lessons per day – 7 lessons a day missed if your child is absent. 35 lessons if your child is off for a week!
