Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will be aware through Parent App notifications, and the media – it is very important for you to consider allowing your child to get the Flu Nasal Spray. This is going to be administered in school on **13th October** to children whose parents have given consent.

GP's are concerned - they expect a rise in flu cases this winter due to people not mingling in the same way last winter during flu season, and immune systems could be lower than they should be.

For example - in Ks1 a day consists of Phonics, Reading, English, Handwriting, Maths plus two other lessons per day – 7 lessons a day missed if your child is absent. 35 lessons if your child is off for a week! Please encourage your child to be in school if they can be and please keep to current guidance relating to Covid.
