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Dear Parents and Carers

May I start by thanking you for supporting school and the social distancing measures we have put into place, the children returned to school very well this week – they all look very smart in their new school uniforms and are having a lovely time in class.

Currently we are not allowing any parents in school; therefore please ensure all equipment for the day is sent in with the children.

Thank you for bearing with us in the change of dropping off and picking up procedures this week – we now have a more workable system of a morning.

New updated changes

From Monday Y1 and Y2 will be dismissed at 3pm from KS1 Playground to try and reduce the amount of parents, pupils and staff on the Ks1 playground 3.15pm.

Y3 and 4 pupils will be dismissed as usual from KS1 playground 3.15pm

Y5 and 6 children will be dismissed from the KS2 playground at 3.15pm

On days when it is raining

On the days when it is raining Year one and two children will be dismissed from the KS1 ramp on the Ks1 playground.

Y3 and Y4 children will all be dismissed from the KS1 playground:

-Class Plessington will be dismissed from their classroom door

-Class Howard will be dismissed from the brown fire-doors behind the KS1 ramp

-Class Kirby will be dismissed from the Blue door to the left of Class Plessington door (parents please line up along the building.

Y5 and Y6 will be dismissed from the school hall, parents please walk along the drive and enter the playground through the double gates in between the cars, once you collect your child please exit the playground by the single gate by the hall doors.

Medical issues

If you or your child has had a Covid – 19 test you do not need to self-isolate if your test is negative, as long as:

- everyone you live with **who has symptoms** tests negative
- you were not told to self-isolate for 14 days by NHS Test and Trace
- you feel well – if you feel unwell, stay at home until you're feeling better



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If your child has COVID-19 symptoms, and they get tested and the test is negative, the procedures for returning to school are as follows:

If the child is NOT a known contact of a confirmed case the child can return to school if the result is negative, provided they feel well and they have not had a fever for 48 hours.

If the child is a contact of a confirmed case they must stay off school for the 14 day isolation period, even if they test negative. This is because they can develop the infection at any point up to day 14 (the incubation period for COVID-19), so if a child tests negative on day 3 they may still go on to develop the infection.

If your child has had a negative covid-19 test result but they have been in contact with a person whose test result was positive - they cannot return to school and must complete 14 days of isolation.

Breakfast Club and After School Club

Breakfast Club will continue from 8.00am daily. All places for Y1 – Y6 must be booked and paid for via Parent Pay the week before attendance.

Price for breakfast club is £2.00 per day.

After School Club will start again on Monday 7th September 2020. As per the notification sent out at the beginning of the week all places must be booked and paid for by 12pm on a Friday the week before the After school club place is needed.

School uniform

Some pupils have returned to school in polo shirts – all pupils should wear a pale blue shirt with the school tie this term and not polo shirts.

Uniform for all pupils from Reception class to Y6

Uniform consist of:

- Pale Blue short sleeved shirt and school ties (No school polo shirts until after Easter)
- Grey Skirt, pinafores or long trousers
- Royal Blue School Jumpers with badge
- Black school shoes (No trainers, gel shoes, heeled shoes or boots allowed)
- Grey, royal blue or white socks
- Small **royal blue, gold or white** hair bobbles/ ribbons/ headbands
- hair past shoulder length must be tied back.**
- No jewellery except small stud earrings and a wrist watch.
- PE Kits must be in school every week:** White t-shirt (with school badge) with royal blue shorts and black pumps.
- Please purchase a school pump bag for your child's PE kit and a school reading bag for Nursery – Y2– no other bags are allowed in school.
