**May 2018**

**National Context** The government have provided funding to improve provision of physical education (PE), sport and healthy, active lifestyles in primary schools. This funding is provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport.

**Funding for 2017-2018** Saints Peter and Paul received £18390.00 (£16000 plus £2390) School Sport Premium Funding (7/12 of funding allocation on 31 October 2017 and 5/12 of funding allocation on 30 April 2018).

**Purpose of funding** Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

**Possible uses for the funding might include:**

- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers when teaching PE
- supporting and engaging the least active children through new or additional Change4Life clubs
- paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- running sport competitions, or increasing children's participation in the School Games
- buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport
- providing places for children on after school sports clubs and holiday clubs pooling the additional funding with that of other local schools.

### **Accountability**

From September 2013, schools have been held to account over how they spend their additional, ring-fenced funding. Ofsted strengthened the coverage of PE and sport within the 'Inspectors' handbook' and supporting guidance so that both schools and inspectors knew how sport and PE would be assessed in future as part of the school's overall provision.

Schools are required to include details of their provision of PE and sport on their website, alongside details of their broader curriculum, so that parents can compare sports provision between schools, both within and beyond the school day.

- C. perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations
