## The AIM Project

### *Understanding and Managing Sexual Behaviours in Education Settings*

The AIM Project has been working in the field of children and adolescents with harmful sexual behaviour for over 20 years and is one of the leading U.K. and international organisations working in this area. In 2020, AIM launched the update to their Education Guidance, and are offering training alongside the document.

Following the OfSTED Rapid Review relating to incidents of Sexual Harassment and Sexual Violence reported in schools, you will not be surprised to learn that Draft, KCSiE 2021, has a strong focus on Peer on Peer abuse and Sexual Harassment and Sexual Violence.

In order for the Designated Safeguarding Leads in all schools across Knowsley to be among the first nationally to receive training relating to this issue I am looking to purchase, on behalf of the schools, training from AIM.

The cost to schools of this training is as follows;

**£130.00** per delegate with a maximum of up to 2 delegates per school

Schools who have purchased the School Safeguarding SLA for 2021/22 will pay a reduced rate of **£85.00** per delegate with a maximum of 2 delegates per school.

Thanks to colleagues in CAPE and links with the DfE, I have had a sneaky peek at the new draft version of KCSiE, 2021.

This draft document will be published sometime around the 6<sup>th</sup> July, with a view to it coming into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sept 2021. The following template school safeguarding policies,

- Child Protection
- Allegations Management
- Safer Recruitment

provided by Knowsley will be updated and reviewed in light of the new guidance and will be available to all schools before the beginning of the new term.

## NCSC (National Cyber Security Centre) cybersecurity training package.

On Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> April 2021 the NCSC (National Cyber Security Centre) released a cybersecurity training package for school staff in response to the large number of attacks we're seeing affecting the education sector across the UK over the last 12 months.

This cyber security training is provided free and its aim is to raise awareness and help school staff manage some of the key cyber threats facing schools.

The presentation pack can be used by schools *and* the education sector to help teach school staff at physical or virtual group sessions - like INSET days or staff meetings.
