Attendance and Punctuality

Attendance and punctuality will be monitored throughout the year. We will work closely with our Attendance officer from Knowsley Council.

The school gates close at 8,55am; if you are late and the gate is closed you will have to **bring** your child into the school office

Quick Reminders:

- Please remember to have inhalers in school if your child/ren are asthmatic; all last year's Asthma letters/Asthma cards are in your child's new asthma folder. If your child has been recently diagnosed with Asthma or your child no longer has Asthma could you inform your class teacher. Inhalers need to be given to school in original box with pharmacy label on.
- Send in your child's new contact sheet with up to date mobile numbers x2 plus address both legal requirements
- Send in your child's form stating who is able to collect your child from school ASAP
- Ensure your child brings all equipment, water bottles, money, lunchboxes etc <u>DO NOT PASS THESES ITEMS IN THROUGH</u>
 THE OFFICE
- If your child is under the weather and require medicine medicine can be administered in school. Only medicine with a Pharmacy label stating your child's name will be administered when parents fill in a medicine form at the office. It has to be medicine that needs administering 4 times a day only All medicine must be brought to and collected from the office by an adult.

Autumn / Winter Uniforms

- Pale blue short sleeved shirt
- School tie (blue with yellow stripes) on string for KS1/FS, clips on for KS2
- Royal blue cardigan/jumper (with school badge)

Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC)

You may have seen recent media coverage regarding Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) and its use in educational settings. RAAC is a lightweight form of concrete; because it is weaker than regular concrete, concerns have been raised about its long-term durability. The Department for Education (DfE) has recently changed its guidance to education settings on the management of RAAC to take a more precautionary approach, and as a result areas in affected spaces will be vacated.

We wanted to inform you that we are not affected by this decision as we do not have RAAC in our building, and therefore we will continue to function as normal. We understand that parents may want to understand more about the support to educational settings to manage RAAC safely.
